



## WORKSHOP THEME 8 OCEAN LITERACY

Ocean literacy addresses formal and non-formal education, involving, among others, schools, science centres and museums for the creation of educational resources around the marine environment and ecosystems, and to boost the presence of marine issues in media.

One of the first European countries to implement an ocean literacy framework, both in formal and non-formal education, was Portugal in 2011, under the leadership of Ciência Viva, the Portuguese National Agency for Scientific and Technological Culture. In the same year, the European Marine Science Educators Association (EMSEA) was created, following the path initiated in the USA, with the promotion of Ocean Literacy among its main goals. Since then, several projects on this subject have been promoted and it has gained an outstanding role within the implementation of the Galway Statement on Atlantic Ocean Cooperation. Ocean Literacy is currently being promoted through several initiatives at regional, national, European and International levels. Efforts are being made to expand the audience and pathways for a widespread delivery of marine knowledge so that it can release its potential towards different targets such as the marine and maritime industries and as many geographic areas as possible; developing countries.
